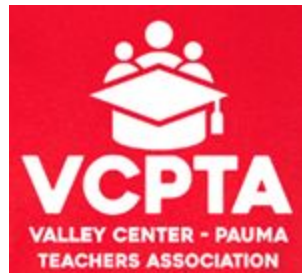
Instructional Best Practices
